



LANDSCAPE TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

PHC Northwest offers a free landscape training program for people with disabilities. The program begins with a two-day orientation emphasizing safety and basic field skills taught here at the PHC facilities. Once the orientation is complete the trainee moves to on the job training in the field working with our experienced landscape staff.

Trainees are paid \$9.06 per hour; the program times are Monday through Friday, 7am to 3:30pm. After successful completion of the training, trainees will receive a certification of completion and applicants are eligible for permanent employment with our company.

BASIC SKILLS LEARNED IN TRAINING:

Pruning (selective shearing and proper pruning techniques), **Turf grass management** (including mowing, trimming/edging, dethatching, fertilization, basic irrigation, and aeration), **Annual flower bed preparation and planting techniques** (including liquid fertilization and soil amendments), and **Landscape installation**.



REQUIREMENTS:

- Documentation of a disability
- Pass criminal background check
- Pass a drug screen
- Must be at least 18 years of age.



***** Landscape training requires the individual is capable of working safely along busy streets and highways; have the ability to discriminate visually by size, shape and color; physical flexibility for bending, stooping and walking; ability to read and write; ability to follow directions for multiple steps tasks; eye-hand-foot coordination within normal range; lift up to 50lbs; stamina to work at physical task for 8 hours days and willingness to work in all weather conditions.**
